


Alabama School of Fine Arts Theatrical Lighting Project with J.S. Cotney

When the Alabama School of Fine Arts in Birmingham raised the curtain on a new, 500-seat theater, the Dorothy Jemison Day Theater, they unveiled a versatile proscenium venue that can accommodate stage plays, dance recitals, orchestral and vocal performances. To meet their technical needs, J.S. Cotney provided ASFA with several products from Philips Strand Lighting. Strand Fresnels hang on battens above the stage to provide broad, even illumination for specific lighting scenarios. The entire lighting system is controlled by a Strand C21 dimmer rack, located in an isolated room to the side of the house. Plus, lighting cues are run with the Strand Palette VL16 control console with 500 channels, 2 DMX ports with 1024 outputs, integrated moving light controls, Vision.net control interface for entertainment and architectural controls, thousands of cue presets, tracking or whole cue operation, and much more.
